STEP ONE: DEVELOP A SOCIAL SERVICES "ECOSYSTEM MAP"

Utilize this template to create a list of local human social service providers in your area, organized by area of focus! Be sure to make a copy of the document before editing.

Google your local human services agencies, by searching your location and area of need. Local municipality websites are also a great place to identify what's available. If needed, ask a volunteer to help research!

3

Consider using <u>findhelp.org</u> to search for human services in your area, specifically low cost programs that aim to support your local community members!

Consider looking on the organization's leadership page for contact information. Once found, utilize the template above to track the organization name, contact information, and area of support (i.e. food pantry, financial assistancance, housing support, etc.)
